# Day 1-13th May

#### **Conditions of Entry:**

- Horses can have 3 starts per day.
- Rider is to be dressed neatly in EA code of dress for Competitions, Light colored jods or breeches and shirt to cover arms. Summer uniform will be encouraged and presentation for orgainsers and judge is to be thought of and adhered to.
- Please make sure you have adequate buckets for water and cold drinks
- There will be no noncompetitive entries allowed.
- Medical Levy \$15 per rider for sunday and Ground Fee \$15 per horse per day
- Max 5 horse in the warm up and please stick to the whiteboard draw order

- All Riders must be a member of Equestrian Australia. If you are unsure, please contact us and we will direct you to the link you need to make this happen for you to become a member of EA nsw as a full member or Participant
- How to become a Member | Equestrian New South Wales
- All riders must always wear riding boots and an approved helmet that is Tagged by a Equestrian Australia qualified helmet tagger, whilst mounted & including presentations.
- NO REFUNDS after close of entries unless veterinary/medical certificate is provided, minus 10% of the total. For scratching's made **prior to close of entries**, competitors will be refunded their entries, minus 20% of the total. This is to cover transaction fees charged to the event organiser as well as the time taken to process the refund.
- The VRSJ reserve the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit, also refuse entry due to conflict or horse welfare.
- If you have a fall you are to report directly to First Aid person to be cleared to ride.
- Equipment Supplied and hired from MN & LA Light showjumping equipment
- Prizes for each class will be awarded immediately following the event.
- All entries must be <u>www.globalentriesonline.com.au</u> No entries will be accepted without payment.
- The show organizers reserve the right to refuse entries once the classes are full.
- Dogs if you bring them please make sure that they always remain on a lead and tethered, And adhere to Grafton showground policies, Dogs are NOT allowed in main ring while jumping competition is in progress.
- All riders competing at the event will be expected to have read and accepted the conditions of entry and by ticking the waiver form they agree to abide by show organizers conditions.
