Cross Country Judges

Each Club MUST provide one cross country judge or assistant for the first rider and then one every three riders or part thereof entered.

The Benalla Pony Club Cross Country Course will be closed from February 21st 2020.

Back Numbers will be supplied on the day and must be worn for Cross Country phase of the competition. Numbers must be returned before leaving the competition. Bridle or saddle cloth numbers are permitted for dressage and show jumping.

All riders riding in Open sections must complete attached Liability Declaration form and if not member of EA, HRCAV, Interstate PC, AERA, Arabian Horse Society or PCV must pay \$15 day participant fee, in addition to entry fee. Please bring relevant paperwork and proof of membership and present this prior to riding on the day. Completed day attendance forms can be emailed to arwaddell@iinet.net.au prior to the event.

Minimum Age - rider must be age 8 or older to be eligible to compete in Horse Trials

Brush fences must be regularly maintained and allow horses to pass readily through the brush and not present a 'solid' element to the fence.

The material used must be such that the risk of injury to horses is a small as possible. Thick stems and sharp ends after trimming/cutting must be avoided.

It is recommended that the back of the brush box be 5cms lower than the front

C.11.5. Specifications for Showjumping phase of Horse Trials & Combined Training.

The limits on the height and spread of obstacles laid down by these rules must be observed with the greatest care. However, if it should happen that a maximum dimension has been marginally exceeded as a result of the material used for construction and/or by the position of the obstacle on the ground, the maximum dimensions laid down will not be considered as having been exceeded, but the permitted tolerance is 5cm maximum in height and 10cm in width, where no other alternative exists.

C.11.6. Minimum Age

Rider must be age 8 or older to be eligible to compete in Horse Trials, no minimum age for Combined Training

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1. PCV club member cards must be presented to the secretary's office before riding for inspection.
- 2. Rider Numbers the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Back numbers will be supplied and must be returned to the office before leaving the competition. Bridle or Saddle Cloth Numbers are permitted for dressage and Show Jumping.
- 3. No refunds after closing date except with vet or medical certificate. An admin fee of \$10 will be deducted.
- 4. Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- 5. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- 6. Lungeing is permitted in lungeing arena. Lungeing at this competition must take place in the confined arena designated exclusively for lungeing, by the organising committee. Riders under the age of 14 may have another competent person over the age of 14 lunge their horse in the designated lungeing area. For riders 14 & over only the competitor may ride or lunge his/her horse or pony in the designated lungeing arena. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.

- 7. All riders must wear complying helmets. Spot checks to ensure compliance may occur and incorrect helmet will mean elimination. The helmets worn must comply with PCV Standards. As of 1st January EN1384 helmets manufactured in 2016 will not be approved for use. Refer to PCV website.
- 8. Gear check is required by all riders prior to competition and after any alteration/adjustment to gear for each phase of the competition.
- 9. Medical Armbands are optional, however strongly encouraged..
- 10. Queries, protests, horse abuse as per the PCV Handbook of By-Laws.
- 11. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
- 12. No stallions, colts or rigs, horses must be at least 4yrs old.
- 13. PCV Alcohol Policy applies.
- 14. Competitors may ride a maximum of two horses subject to the conditions of PCV Handbook of By-laws multiple horse rules.
- 15. Neither the organising committee of this competition, Benalla Pony Club, nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- 16. Condition of Entry includes agreeing to Horse Veterinary Authority and Medical Response Authority found at following link http://www.ponyclubvic.org.au/site/ponyclub/vic/downloads/Events/Club%20Z one%20Event%20Template%20Forms%20and%20Info/Medical%20and%20Veterinar y%20Authority.doc
- 17. Stabling and yards should be of solid construction. The use of electrified tape, strings, ropes or chains is not permitted at Pony Club Events. Electric tape can be used as a top line or standoff on a steel or solid yard, but not as a stand alone yard.
- 18. Each Club MUST provide one cross country judge or assistant, for the first rider and then one every three riders or part thereof entered.
- 19. Individual entries must supply one cross country judge
- 20. Any rider under eight years of age may not compete in horse trials.
- 21. Pony Club riders must wear full pony club uniform. Open riders may wear HRCAV uniform, pony club uniform, formal riding attire or neat polo/rugby style top or jacket. Jodhpurs or moleskins must be worn and in the colour of banana, beige, white or fawn. As per PCV Uniform rules.
- 22. All open competitors must complete a liability waiver and day attendance form if applicable and return with entry.
- 23. Equality of scores will be separated as per PCV handbook of bylaws for Horse Trials.

All riders riding in Open sections must complete attached Liability Declaration form and if not member of EA, HRCAV, Interstate PC, AERA, Arabian Horse Society or PCAV must pay \$10 day membership, in addition to entry fee. Please bring relevant paperwork and proof of membership and present this prior to riding on the day. The \$15 fee if applicable is not part of the entry fee and must be paid when entering.

Day Participant Waiver and Liability Declaration Instructions for Open Sections



Purpose of Form:

The purpose of the Day Participant Waiver and Liability Declaration is to ensure appropriate insurance is in place to allow Non-Pony Club members the opportunity to ride Open Pony Club Sections upon the payment of the insurance fee levied by our insurers, or to claim an exemption if the rider holds appropriate insurance through their membership of a recognised organisation, or otherwise insured.

Pony Club Junior, Associate and Adult riding members of any state, through membership, have completed a Waiver and are automatically covered by PCA insurance and do not complete this form.

Cost: Non-Pony Club members and PCA/PCV members who cannot prove their PCA/PCV membership must pay \$15 per day of participation unless exempt by way of holding insurance (as per Page 2 -Liability Declaration) with an equine organization or hold their own insurance.

Insurance Coverage: There is no personal accident cover for Non-Pony Club members. This cover extends to Public Liability only.

Who Completes This Form (both pages)? All Non-Pony Club members, and any Pony Club member that cannot show their Pony Club card or prove Pony Club membership.

Day Participant and/or Guardian Instructions to Complete Form:

- Complete BOTH pages.
- All details of the Day Participant Waiver (page 1) must be completed
 - For participants aged under 18, the Waiver must be signed by the participant's Parent/Guardian.
- Complete the relevant details of the Liability Declaration (page 2).
 - o If the rider is a member of one of the listed equine associations, fill out the details of the equine association and the member number in the space provided.
 - Tick the box of the equine association the participant is a member of (if any).
 - For participants aged under 18, the Liability declaration must be signed by the participant's Parent/Guardian.

Organising Committee Statement of Riding Requirements

The organising committee must state what riding requirements (specifications) apply for each grade/class/section of the competition/activity. The specifications must be detailed on the entry information before accepting an entry. The statement must advise: -

- A) Which grade the specifications will be equivalent to, if applicable
- B) Maximum jump heights and spreads, if applicable

PCV Club Members and Interstate Pony Club Members

- The 'grade/riding specification' selected by a Pony Club member in an open section may be different to the grade(s) on the PCV member card.
- Pony Club members may ride in an open and/or a pony club section, but not in the same grade, on the same mount except in horse trials.
